

Charles City Dirt Riders Rules

- You must have a CCDR sticker on your vehicle (REAR WINDOW) and the responsible adult, parent or member must have a membership card in their possession. Club officers are tired of trying to police who are members and who are not.**
 - Ride and spectate at your own risk
 - Absolutely no consumption of alcohol while riding
 - Guest passes are only arranged for in advance, no passes at the track, as there are probably no club officers around to issue the pass. If you have a guest, **THEY MUST JOIN THE CLUB AND PAY THE RIDE FEE.... arrangements must be made in advance and not the day of, for pass and signing of liability forms.**
 - Do not ride when the track is excessively muddy or dusty
 - No riding during hunting season--Thanksgiving through Jan 30--except on Sundays (club reserves right to close track completely, and as necessary due to dust, mud, hunting, etc.
 - No riding unless you are a member (No free rides to check out track; No free rides because you're a friend of [insert name here]....etc.)
 - No loud motorcycles.** Guys, we're getting complains about the noise of some of these bikes, *from neighbors who are over a mile away!* Noise, dust and being disrespectful about other property owner's rights **are the sure way to get this place closed down.** Pay attention, use common sense and don't be the one that ruins it for everyone else.
 - No cutting the track or riding around jumps** and cutting back in on the other side of the jump—roll the jumps but don't go around as this creates a dangerous situation if someone behind is already committed to jumping
 - Ride to the left of the track when you are being overtaken from behind—parents explain how important this is to your children. Kids, explain it to your parents.**
 - We have a beginner track (small bikes and novices) and the advance track—ride the appropriate track for your skill level *and stay off the other track.*
 - Do not use any of the equipment (dozer, tractor etc) or operated the water pumps without permission.**
 - No four wheelers
 - No speeding in front of pits between pits and track. 5mph (first gear only). **FIRST GEAR ONLY ON ROADS**
 - Absolutely no riding on the main roads. These are private roads that are owned and maintained by the Shirley and we are their guests.
 - Absolutely no riding on the airfield (to the left of main entrance) or the farm fields—no matter how inviting they look.
 - Stop if you see someone on a horse—stop and do not move! Turn off your motorcycle and let them pass.**
 - Proper riding gear at all times (helmets, boots, eye protection, MX pants , chest protector, etc.
 - Must be willing to help out occasionally on work days (at least two or more per year plus special occasions)**
 - Do not ride if you see hunters or horse riders anywhere on property
 - TAKE MORE TRASH THAN YOU BRING... TAKE MORE TRASH THAN YOU BRING... TAKE MORE TRASH THAN YOU BRING**
 - Parents-you are responsible for your kids. Instruct them on how to ride safely—on and off the track. Kids, watch your parents.**
- This is an "honor system" riding facility. You've paid your dues, so please help your fellow club members police riders who are trespassing. If they want to ride here, then they should pay the very reasonable dues and have a great time.*
